Free School Tour Admission Grant Guidelines

Old Independence Regional Museum tells the stories of the twelve counties that once made up Independence County. We are always looking for ways to serve the outlying counties and the schools from the region that we represent. Our Free School Tour Admission Grant is provided to area schools to make visiting the museum feasible.

- 1. The grant is administered by museum staff.
- 2. Every effort is made to ensure that at least one school from each of the twelve counties receives a grant.
- 3. Bus stipends may be available for schools more than 10 miles from the museum.
- 4. The tour offered, unless otherwise indicated, will include the Depression Era Back Porch, Shawnee Town, Region on the Move, and Civil War exhibits, along with 19th Century Toys and Games.
- 5. Any group receiving school tour admission grant funds will visit the Gift Shop as part of the tour. Teachers are encouraged to notify students and parents/guardians that they will be visiting the Gift Shop. (See sample letter below.) Our gift shop stocks many items of various prices to fit even small budgets.
- 6. This grant program is generously funded by a private donor. We ask recipients to send summaries of their visits or thank you notes which will be shared with the donor.
